## **CHARGING AND REMISSIONS POLICY**

The governors of Hillborough Infant and Nursery School adhere to the principle of free education during school hours in a Local Authority maintained school.

We believe that our children benefit from being given a wide range of experiences to enhance the Curriculum, therefore are occasions when voluntary contributions may be requested from parents towards the cost of:

- Specific school equipment;
- Educational visits.

The contribution must be genuinely voluntary and pupils of parents who are unable to contribute may not be discriminated against.

However, we know that many parents cannot afford to make contributions, so it is our policy to provide arrange of activities, both in and out of school, without charging parents excessively or too regularly.

Where there are not enough voluntary contributions to make the activity possible and it is not possible to make up the shortfall, then the activity will be cancelled.
